



## **Data Privacy**

### **Data Privacy Policy**

You can visit our webpages also without providing any personal data. Our website stores to some extent personal data of users or also data relating to individuals. The law defines such personal data as information about personal and factual circumstances of an identified or identifiable natural person (Sec. 3 (1) German Federal Data Protection Act). This includes, for example, the name, address, email address or phone number. According to the prevalent opinion, also the IP address that is assigned to each computer specifically by a provider is considered to be data that can identify a person. Not considered to be personal data is information based on which you cannot be identified (anonymised data) such as the mere specification of age or gender without reference to your person.

#### **Storing of data by our website / server data**

By means of so-called server files, our website initially stores automatically (thus not via a registration) general information that is used without reference to specific persons. The web servers and statistics programs that are used store by default, e.g.:

- browser type and version,
- operating system in use,
- host name of the accessing computer (IP address),
- time of the server query.

This information is stored exclusively for the purposes of the technical administration of our website. It will not be transferred to third parties. This anonymous data is stored separately from any personal data potentially provided by you and it therefore does not permit any conclusions as to a specific person. The data is analysed for purposes of statistics so as to be able to optimise our internet appearance and our offers.

#### **Data storage by means of your data entries**

On our website, information about you is also actively gathered when, for example, you enter information in our contact form or sign up for our newsletter. This information is of course used exclusively to perform the service offered by us. The data will not be transferred to servers outside of the EU.

The provisions below inform you in this respect about the kind, scope and purpose of the gathering, use and processing of personal data by the provider:

### **Storage**

After the purpose for which the data was gathered no longer applies, we store your personal data only for as long as required based on legal regulations (in particular, e.g. tax regulations).

### **Designated purpose**

The personal data provided by you will generally be used by us to answer your requests, process your orders, execute contracts concluded with you or provide access for you to certain information or offers. If we receive your email address in connection with the sale of a product or service and if you have not objected, we reserve sending you regular emails with offers from our product range that are similar to the products you have already purchased.

### **Transfer of your information**

We will neither transfer, sell nor otherwise market your personal data to third parties without your consent or instruction.

You can object to this use of your email address at any time by sending a message to the contact details specified below, without this causing any costs besides the transmission fees according to the base tariffs.

Of course, we will respect it if you do not wish support our customer relationship by providing us with your personal data. If you do not want this, you can send your consent or revocation of the consent for the use of your personal data at any time with effect for the future to the contact specified below.

### **Use for designated purpose**

We will gather, process, and use the personal data provided by you online exclusively for the purposes disclosed to you, unless the gathering, processing or use

- takes place for a further purpose that relates directly to the original purpose for which the personal data has been gathered,
- is required for the preparation, negotiation and fulfilment of a contract with you,
- is required based on a legal obligation or order from an authority or court,
- is required to establish or protect legal claims or for the defence against claims,
- serves to prevent abuse or other illegal activities, e.g. intentional attacks on IT systems and for assuring data security.

### **Contact option**

On our website, we offer the option for you to contact us via email and/or a contact form. In that case, the information provided by the user will be stored and processed for the purpose of handling his/her contact request. It will not be transferred to third parties. The data that is gathered this way will likewise not be reconciled against the data potentially gathered by other components of our website.



### **Use of Google Maps**

This website used Google Maps, a map service of Google operated by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA ("Google"). In the use of Google Maps, Google also gathers, processes and uses data about the use of the map features by visitors to the webpages. ### **Publication of job classifieds/online job applications**

Your job application data will be gathered and stored electronically by us for the purpose of processing the application procedure. If an employment contract is concluded upon your application, data transmitted by you can be stored by us in observation of the relevant legal regulations, in your personnel file for the purpose of the customary organisational and administrative process, in particular the execution of the employment contract.

If your job application is declined, the data transmitted by you in the course of the application procedure will be deleted automatically two months after we have notified you that we decline. This does not apply if a longer period of storage is necessary due to legal requirements (e.g. the burden of proof according to the General Equal Treatment Act) or if you have expressly agreed to a longer period of storage in our database of candidates.

### **Your rights**

#### Information

You can demand information about whether we process personal data of you and, if this is the case, you have a right to obtain confirmation of this personal data and the further information specified in Art. 15 GDPR.

#### Right to correction

You have the right according to Art. 16 GDPR to demand the correction of personal data relating to you that is inaccurate and the completion of incomplete personal data.

#### Right to erasure

You have the right to demand from us that the personal data relating to you be deleted immediately. We are obligated to erase this data immediately, especially if one of the following reasons applies:

- your personal data is no longer required for the purposes for which it has been gathered or otherwise processed.
- You revoke your consent that has served as the basis for the processing of your data and there is no other legal basis for the processing.
- Your data has been processed unlawfully.

The right to erasure does not apply if your personal data is required to assert, enforce or defend against legal claims.



### Right to limit the processing

You have the right to demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data if

- you deny the correctness of the data and we therefore review the correctness;
- the processing is illegitimate and you reject the deletion, and instead request the restriction of the use;
- we no longer need the data, but you require it for the assertion, enforcement of or defence against legal claims;
- you objected to the processing of your data and it is not certain yet if our legitimate interests override your reasons.

### Right to data portability

You have the right to receive the personal data relating to you and which you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and you have the right that this data be transmitted without obstruction by us to another data controller, insofar as the processing is based on a consent or a contract and the processing is implemented by means of automated processes.

### Right of revocation

**Insofar as the processing of your personal data is based on a consent, you have the right to revoke the consent at any time.**

### General remarks and right to lodge complaint

The exercise of your aforementioned rights is generally free of charge for you. In the case of complaints, you have the right to contact the supervisory authority competent for us, the state data protection officer, directly.
